# Equine Activity Warning, Assumption of Risk, and Release

Read carefully. This page affects legal rights.

## New Jersey equine activity warning

WARNING: Under New Jersey law, an equestrian area operator is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine animal activities, pursuant to P.L. 1997, c.287 (C.5:15-1 et seq.).

## ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I understand that horseback riding, handling horses, grooming, feeding, tacking, leading, mounting, dismounting, riding in indoor and outdoor arenas, participating in games or barn activities, walking on farm property, and being around horses, equipment, other participants, and changing weather involve known and unknown risks. These risks include horses biting, kicking, bucking, bolting, spooking, stopping suddenly, stepping on a participant, or reacting unpredictably to sound, movement, weather, other animals, objects, or people; falling or being thrown; collisions; arena footing; uneven, slippery, or muddy ground; fences, gates, stalls, tools, tack, farm equipment, vehicles, heat, cold, rain, insects, allergies, dust, other outdoor or barn conditions, and the actions or inactions of the camper, other participants, staff, visitors, or third parties. Serious injury, permanent disability, death, emotional distress, and property damage can occur even when rules are followed and reasonable care is used.

## SUITABILITY AND ACTIVITY DECISIONS

I certify that the camper information I provide is accurate and complete, including riding, medical, allergy, medication, behavior, limitation, and support information. River Vu Farms may evaluate a camper's readiness, assign horses and activities, require additional instruction, limit participation, or remove a camper from an activity if River Vu Farms determines participation may be unsafe for the camper, other participants, staff, horses, or property.

## RELEASE OF PARENT/GUARDIAN CLAIMS

To the fullest extent permitted by New Jersey law, and in consideration of my child's participation in River Vu Farms camp, I, the undersigned parent or legal guardian, on behalf of myself and my own claims, release, waive, discharge, and agree not to sue River Vu Farms; its owners; managers; employees; instructors; volunteers; agents; contractors; horse owners; property owners; and anyone acting on their behalf (together, the 'Released Parties') for claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, costs, attorney's fees, or liabilities arising out of or related to my child's participation in camp, equine animal activities, farm activities, use of facilities, emergency response, or presence on the property, including claims alleging ordinary negligence by any Released Party.

## MINOR CLAIMS / LIMITS ON WAIVER

I understand that New Jersey law may limit a parent or guardian's ability to release a minor child's future injury claims. This agreement is intended to be enforced only to the fullest extent permitted by law. It is not intended to waive claims that cannot legally be waived, including claims based on gross negligence, recklessness, willful or wanton conduct, intentional misconduct, or statutory rights that cannot be waived.

## INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Released Parties from claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, and attorney's fees arising from: inaccurate or incomplete information I provide; failure by me or my child to follow River Vu Farms rules or staff instructions; my child's intentional, reckless, or unsafe conduct; property damage caused by me or my child; or claims brought by me or by family members arising from my own released claims. This indemnity is not intended to require indemnification where prohibited by New Jersey law.

I have read the NJ equine warning, assumption of risk, release, waiver limits, and indemnity terms.

The camper information I provided is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge.



# Rules, Payment, Photo Choice, and Signature

Parent/legal guardian signature is required before registration is accepted.

### EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

If I cannot be reached in an emergency, I authorize River Vu Farms to provide or arrange reasonable first aid, contact emergency medical services, transport my child for emergency medical or dental care, and authorize emergency medical providers to examine and treat my child as medically necessary. I understand River Vu Farms does not provide accident or medical insurance and I am responsible for medical, ambulance, hospital, prescription, and related costs. River Vu Farms does not administer medication unless specifically agreed in writing.

### SAFETY, CLOTHING, BEHAVIOR, AND REFUNDS

Campers must follow River Vu Farms safety rules and staff instructions. An ASTM/SEI approved equestrian helmet is required when mounted and whenever staff requires it; farm helmets are available. Campers must wear long pants, closed-toe shoes or boots with a hard sole and small heel, shirts tucked in when riding, and long hair tied back. Sandals, flip-flops, open-toe shoes, smooth fashion shoes, and heavy lug soles are not permitted around horses. Parent/guardian must disclose medical, behavioral, developmental, allergy, medication, or support needs before camp. River Vu Farms may restrict activities, consider reasonable accommodations when feasible, call for pickup, decline participation, or dismiss a camper if participation presents a safety risk, requires care beyond available program resources, or substantially disrupts camp. Decisions are based on safety/program fit, not protected status. Campers bring lunch Monday-Thursday and drinks each day; pizza is supplied on Fridays. Parent/guardian must notify River Vu Farms of food allergies and restrictions before camp. Camp is \$625/week. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due with registration; balance is due on the first day. Registration is subject to availability and farm confirmation. No refunds or credits are given for cancellation within 14 days, missed days, early departure, dismissal, or improper clothing/footwear.

This agreement is governed by New Jersey law. If any part of this agreement is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining parts shall remain in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law.
